Johnson, Bro. Stephen H., was perhaps the oldest Mason in this Grand Jurisdiction. He was made a Mason in 1818, and advanced in the higher degrees, was Senior Grand Warden of the Grand Lodge of Mississippi in 1846, and was Grand High Priest of the Grand Chapter from 1861 to 1864. He had lived for more than four score years and had been an active, working Mason for over a half-century when he was called to rest Jan. 22, 1875.

Miles, Bro. Dent H., was made a Mason in Concordia Lodge, No. 13, Baltimore, Md., on the 5th of May, 1822, and died at Belle Station, Tenn., July 20, 1874. He came to Mississippi in 1835, was Senior Grand Warden from 1863 to 1873, and is buried in Yazoo County, Miss.

Robinson, Bro. Henry Cole, was born in Putnam County, Georgia, in 1818, and came to Mississippi at the age of 12 years. He became a Mason in Philadelphia Lodge, No. 93, in 1847,

then moved to Jefferson Lodge, No. 146. He died near Crawfordsville, Miss., Nov. 14, 1874, and was interred in the Rose Hill Masonic Cemetery, Meridian, Miss.
